STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to provide notice to beneficiaries under wills.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. When wills are presented and allowed in the
2 several courts of probate in this State, it shall be the duty of
3 the registers to notify the several beneficiaries under the
4 same that bequests have been made to them and by whom.

Sect. 2. Beneficiaries under wills, notified as provided in
2 section 1 of this act, shall upon application, be furnished
3 with copy of so much of the will as relates to them, upon a
4 payment of a fee of fifty cents, provided the copy does not
5 exceed ten lines on legal cap paper of not less than ten words
6 in each line and five cents for each additional line of ten
7 words.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
