STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to a winter speedway on the Kennebec river at Hallowell.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. J. M. Nichols, Warren Malcolm, S. T. Stilkey, 2 Cushman Walker, Walter Webb and their associates, suc-3 cessors or assigns, are hereby incorporated under the name 4 of the Kennebec Driving Club, and are hereby authorized to 5 mark out and appropriate, yearly, a winter speedway for 6 horses and their drivers on the Kennebec river at Hallowell, 7 at a distance not exceeding one mile northerly or southerly 8 from the town landing, and to charge a reasonable sum to 9 each person who may desire to use the same. Said course 10 shall be located so as not to abridge or impede a reasonable 11 opportunity for public travel without the limits thereof.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
