STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize Justin M. Leavitt to maintain and extend
a wharf to the harbor line into the tide waters of Cape Por-
poise harbor in the town of Kennebunkport.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Justin M. Leavitt and his assigns are hereby
2 authorized to maintain and extend a wharf from the shore
3 front of Milk island, situate at Cape Porpoise in the town of
4 Kennebunkport, into the tide waters of said harbor to the
5 harbor line.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
