STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN.ACT to extend the charter of the Camden and Liberty Railway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Cam-2 den and Liberty Railway which were granted by chapter 3 seventy-five of the private and special laws of nineteen hun-4 dred and three, are hereby extended for two years from the 5 time when this act shall take effect, and the persons named in 6 said chapter seventy-five of said private and special laws of 7 nineteen hundred and three, their associates, successors and 8 assigns, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that 9 were granted them by said chapter seventy-five of said 10 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and three, to be 11 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as 12 herein specified.
