IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Camden and Liberty  
Railway.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Cam-  
2 den and Liberty Railway which were granted by chapter  
3 seventy-five of the private and special laws of nineteen hun-  
4 dred and three, are hereby extended for two years from the  
5 time when this act shall take effect, and the persons named in  
6 said chapter seventy-five of said private and special laws of  
7 nineteen hundred and three, their associates, successors and  
8 assigns, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that  
9 were granted them by said chapter seventy-five of said  
10 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and three, to be  
11 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as  
12 herein specified.
