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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter five hundred fifty-seven of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred ninety-three, entitled, "An Act to Incorporate the Home for Aged Men in Bangor."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of said chapter five hundred fifty-  
2 seven of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred  
3 ninety-three is hereby amended by striking out the words  
4 "one hundred" n the fourth and fifth lines of said section,  
5 and inserting in the place thereof the words 'two hundred  
6 and fifty,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-  
7 lows:

‘Sect. 2. Under the above name, said corporation may sue  
9 and be sued, take by purchase, devise, or otherwise, real and  
10 personal property and hold the same for the purposes ex-  
11 pressed in section one, to an amount not exceeding two hun-  
12 dred and fifty thousand dollars, and manage and dispose of  
13 the same for the purposes aforesaid; and shall possess all the  
14 rights, privileges and immunities, which belong to corpora-  
15 tions created for charitable objects, under the laws of this  
16 State.’

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
