STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter four hundred fifteen of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing Drew plantation to raise money for certain purposes."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Said chapter four hundred fifteen of the Private

- 2 and Special Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out section one of said act and inserting
- 4 in the place thereof the following section:

'Section 1. The municipal officers of Drew plantation, in

6 the county of Penobscot, are hereby given all the powers of

7 municipal officers of towns to lay out, alter or widen public 8 or private ways within the plantation, and, so far as applic-9 able, the provisions of chapter twenty-three of the Revised 10 Statutes shall apply to laying out, altering or widening public 11 or private ways in said plantation, and all the powers which 12 towns now have to raise and expend money for the purpose 13 of making and repairing ways, building bridges and paying 14 officers and agents are hereby extended to said plantation.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
