AN ACT to amend paragraph twenty of section one of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to the salary of the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries.


Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph twenty of section one of chapter one

- 2 hundred and sixteen is hereby amended by striking out the
- 3 words "one thousand dollars" and inserting in place thereof
- 4 the words fifteen hundred dollars and actual traveling
- 5 expenses,' so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as
- 6 follows:

'Commissioner of sea and shore fisheries, fifteen hundred 8 dollars and actual traveling expenses.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect the first day of April, 2 nineteen hundred and five.
