IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend and amend the charter of the Patten Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Patten 2 Trust Company, which were granted by chapter two hundred 3 ninety-one of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun-4 dred and three are hereby extended for two years from the 5 approval of this act; and the persons named in said act, their 6 associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers 7 and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exer-8 cised in the same manner and for the same purposes as speci-

9 fied in said act, with such additional powers and privileges 10 as are granted in this act.

Sect. 2. Section 13 of chapter 291 is hereby amended by 2 inserting in the second line after the word "its" the word 3 'net,' so that the section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 13. Such corporation shall set apart as a guaranty 5 fund not less than ten per cent of its net earnings in each 6 and every year until such fund, with the accumulated interest 7 thereon, shall amount to one fourth of the capital stock of 8 said corporation.'

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
