IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the York Light and Heat Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The York Light and Heat Company is hereby
2 authorized and empowered to set, build, extend and maintain
3 its poles, lines and wires along and upon the public highways
4 and streets from the cities of Biddeford and Saco, to, into
5 and through the towns of Dayton, Hollis and Buxton, in the
6 county of York, and to and into the village of Bonny Eagle,
7 in the town of Standish, Cumberland county, under such
8 reasonable restrictions as the municipal officers of said towns
9 may impose as to the kind of poles, the manner in which they

10 shall be set and the height at which the wires shall be carried
11 thereon, for the purpose of supplying light, heat and power
12 in said cities of Biddeford and Saco and in said towns and vil-
13 lage, by the manufacture of gas and electricity as contem-
14 plated and authorized by its organization and charter, and
15 to make and enter into contracts with said towns, or either
16 of them, for the supplying of light, heat and power, and to
17 make and enter into contracts for acquiring power.
