STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relative to moving buildings through the streets.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person, association of persons or corpora-2 tions shall move a building through the public streets and 3 highways of any village or city, without first obtaining a 4 permit from the municipal officers.

Sect. 2. The owner or owners of such building shall be 2 liable to all persons and corporations for damage done to 3 their property and their business by reason of moving such 4 building through the streets and highways of any village or 5 city.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect July 1st, 1905.
