STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of county commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

- Section 1. The annual salary for each county commissioner
- 2 for the several counties, shall be as follows:
 - 3 Androscoggin, six hundred dollars.
 - 4 Aroostook, eleven hundred dollars.
 - 5 Cumberland, one thousand fifty dollars.
 - 6 Franklin, three hundred and fifty dollars.
 - 7 Hancock, seven hundred and fifty dollars.
 - 8 Kennebec, one thousand dollars.
 - 9 Knox, three hundred dollars.
 - 10 Lincoln, three hundred dollars.
 - 11 Oxford, five hundred dollars.
 - 12 Penobscot, twelve hundred dollars.

- 13 Piscataquis, five hundred dollars.
- 14 Sagadahoc, two hundred and fifty dollars.
- 15 Somerset, six hundred and fifty dollars.
- 16 Waldo, four hundred dollars.
- 17 Washington, five hundred and fifty dollars.
- 18 York, seven hundred and fifty dollars.

Said salaries are payable from the county treasuries in quarterly payments on the first days of January, April, July and October of each year, in full for all services, expenses and travel, including the management of the jail workshops and the sale of their products, except actual necessary cash expenses incurred outside of their respective counties for the transaction of official business; all bills for such expenses shall be approved by the clerk of courts and the county attorney of their county.

Sect. 2. For services performed by county commissioners in the assessment of damages for land or easements sought to be taken or acquired by private corporations, they shall charge three dollars a day and actual traveling expenses, and certify the same in a bill of items to the county attorney, who shall collect the sums so charged of the party seeking to exercise the right of eminent domain, and forthwith pay the same to the county treasurer.

Sect. 3. Sections twenty-two, twenty-three and twenty-four of chapter eighty of the Revised Statutes, are hereby repealed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and six.
