IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of county treasurers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The salaries of the treasurers in the following

- 2 named counties shall be paid quarterly from the treasuries
- 3 of their counties as follows:
- 4 Androscoggin, twelve hundred dollars.
- 5 Aroostook, six hundred dollars.
- 6 Cumberland, fifteen hundred dollars.
- 7 Franklin, three hundred dollars.
- 8 Hancock, four hundred and fifty dollars.
- 9 Kennebec, twelve hundred dollars.
- 10 Knox, four hundred dollars.
- 11 Lincoln, three hundred dollars.

- 12 Oxford, five hundred dollars.
- 13 Penobscot, twelve hundred dollars.
- 14 Piscataquis, four hundred dollars.
- 15 Sagadahoc, three hundred and fifty dollars.
- 16 Somerset, four hundred dollars.
- 17 Waldo, four hundred dollars.
- 18 Washington, four hundred dollars.
- 19 York, seven hundred and fifty dollars.

The above salaries shall be in full for all services and

21 expenses, including clerk hire.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of July, 2 one thousand nine hundred and five.
