## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of registers of probate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The registers of probate are entitled to receive

- 2 annual salaries from the treasurers of their counties in quar-
- 3 terly payments on the first days of January, April, July and
- 4 October, as follows:
- 5 Androscoggin, twelve hundred dollars, with two hundred
- 6 dollars additional for clerk hire.
- 7 Aroostook, one thousand dollars.
- 8 Cumberland, seventeen hundred dollars, with fifteen hundred
- o dollars additional for clerk hire.
- 10 Franklin, six hundred dollars.
- 11 Hancock, one thousand dollars, with three hundred dollars
- 12 additional for clerk hire.
- 13 Kennebec, twelve hundred dollars, with three hundred dol-
- 14 lars additional for clerk hire.

- 15 Knox, eight hundred dollars.
- 16 Lincoln, seven hundred dollars.
- 17 Oxford, one thousand dollars.
- 18 Penobscot, fifteen hundred dollars, with eight hundred dol-
- 19 lars additional for clerk hire.
- 20 Piscataquis, six hundred dollars.
- 21 Sagadahoc, seven hundred dollars.
- 22 Somerset, one thousand dollars.
- 23 Waldo, one thousand dollars.
- 24 Washington, nine hundred dollars.
- 25 York, thirteen hundred dollars, with three hundred dollars
- 26 additional for clerk hire.

The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation for 28 the performance of all duties required of registers of probate.

- 29 They shall account quarterly under oath to the county treas-
- 30 urers for the legal and usual fees received by them or pay-
- 31 able to them by virtue of the office, specifying the items, and
- 32 shall pay the whole amount of the same to the treasurers of
- 33 their respective counties quarterly on the first days of Jan-
- 34 uary, April, July and October of each year. On the first day
- 35 of January of each year the registers receiving the sums
- 36 above specified for clerk hire shall make under oath to the
- 37 county treasurers of their respective counties, a statement
- 38 specifying the amount paid by them for that purpose and to
- 39 whom paid during the year next preceding, and shall pay 40 to said treasurers any unexpended balance of such sums in
- 41 their hands.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of July, 2 one thousand nine hundred and five.
