STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section eighteen of chapter one hundred and
seventeen of the Revised Statutes, relating to the fees of reg-
isters of deeds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section eighteen of chapter one hundred and
2 seventeen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by
3 inserting in paragraph eight thereof, the following words:
4 'certificates of organization of corporations, and copies
5 thereof for filing with the secretary of state, five dollars;' so
6 that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Recording certificates of limited partnership, fifty cents;
8 certificates of organization of corporations, and copies thereof
9 for filing with the secretary of state, five dollars; receiving

10 and filing certificate of election of the clerk of a corporation,
11 or resignation of said clerk, twenty-five cents; recording cer-
12 tificates of foreclosure of mortgages or notices of foreclosure
13 fifty cents.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of July,
2 one thousand nine hundred and five.
