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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes, relating to the salary of public officers and compensation of members of the government.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes 2 shall be amended by adding to the last word, viz., by adding 3 to the word "dollars" in the ninth line of paragraph 27 4 thereof, the following words: 'three hundred dollars for 5 commissary in addition to his salary as guard; night-watch- 6 man, five hundred dollars,' so that said paragraph, as 7 amended, shall read as follows: 'Warden of the State 8 prison, eighteen hundred dollars, with the use, without 9 charge, of such part of the keeper's house and buildings of

10 the State, appurtenant to the prison and yard, as the gover-  
11 nor and council may direct, and fuel for his own use ; which  
12 shall be in full for all services, including the duty of receiv-  
13 ing and paying out money for all purposes ; deputy warden,  
14 one thousand dollars ; clerk, one thousand dollars ; officer of  
15 the guard, six hundred dollars ; guards, five hundred dollars  
16 each ; physician, two hundred and fifty dollars ; chaplain,  
17 two hundred and fifty dollars ; gate keeper, five hundred  
18 dollars ; teacher, three hundred dollars ; three hundred dol-  
19 lars for commissary in addition to his salary as guard ; night-  
20 watchman, five hundred dollars.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
