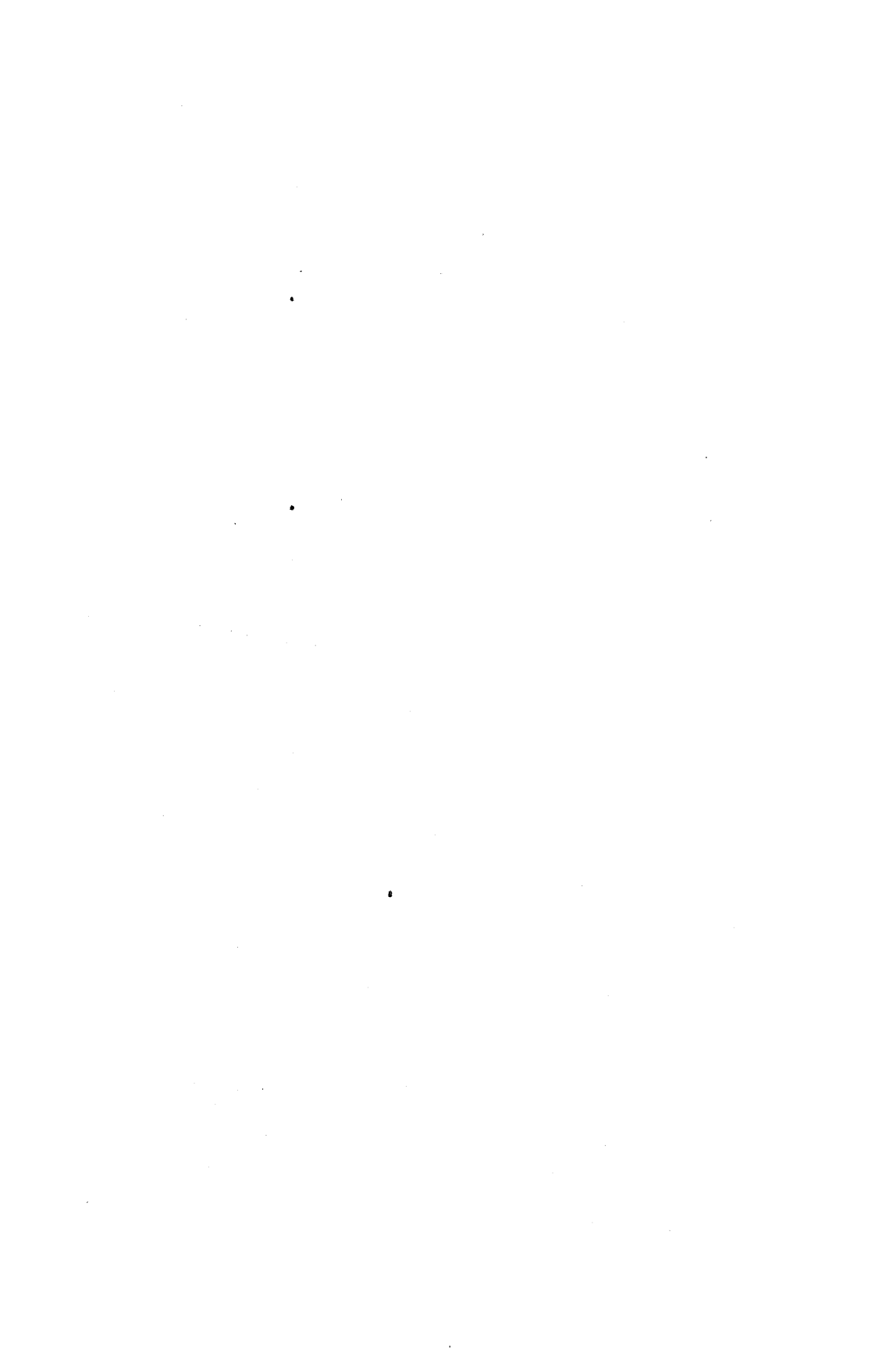
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 223 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903 in relation to establishing a normal school at Presque Isle, in the county of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 223 of the Private and Special Laws of 2 1903 is hereby amended by striking out the word "county" 3 in the second line of said section and inserting in place 4 thereof the word 'state,' so that said section, as amended 5 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Another normal school, to be known as Aroostook State Normal School, is hereby created and established 7 upon such plan as the board of trustees of normal schools 8 may direct.' 9
