STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide for the completion of the residence of
the principal of the Western State Normal School at Gorham.

Resolved, That the sum of three thousand (\$3,000) dollars be
2 and the same hereby is appropriated for the completion of the
3 residence of the principal of the Western State Normal School
4 at Gorham, the same to be expended under the direction of
5 the board of trustees of the State normal schools; one-half
6 of said amount, or fifteen hundred (\$1,500) dollars to be
7 paid to said trustees in the year 1905 and the remaining one-
8 half, or fifteen (\$1,500) dollars in 1906.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the month of June, 1904, Ex-Governor Frederick Robie gave the sum of seven thousand (\$7,000) dollars for the purpose of building a residence for the principal of Gorham Normal School.

On account of the very great and unexpected cost of the cellar and other necessary expenditures the building has already absorbed the generous gift of the distinguished donor and it is estimated that the sum asked for in this resolve will be necessary for its completion.
