IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT authorizing Frank G. Spaulding et als to build a
wharf into tide waters in the town of Cranberry Isles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Frank G. Spurling, Henry E. Spurling, Nettie
2 A. Stanley and Grace M. Hadlock and their assigns are
3 hereby authorized to erect, extend and maintain a wharf
4 from their shore, north of the town landing, into tide waters
5 of Spurling's cove, in the town of Cranberry Isles, county of
6 Hancock, for a distance not exceeding three hundred feet
7 from high water mark.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
