RESOLVE in favor of William H. Reid, State Binder.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of two thousand dollars, or so much  
2 thereof as may be necessary, be and hereby is appropriated  
3 to pay the State binder for balance due for binding the  
4 Revised Statutes, the same to be expended under the direc-  
5 tion of the governor and council.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Out of the forty thousand dollars appropriated in 1903 for "Revision of Statutes," there was an unexpended balance of fourteen thousand one hundred sixty-five dollars and thirty-four cents which has reverted to the State and out of which amount this claim could have been paid, had the last lot of binding been completed in time for bills to have been presented prior to January first, the number of copies remaining unbound on the first day of January, 1905, being about eighteen hundred. This resolve virtually reappropriates two thousand dollars of the amount unused from the appropriation of 1903.
