## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 9 of chapter 108 of the Revised Statutes relating to the service of venires.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section nine of chapter one hundred and eight 2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after 3 the word "meeting" in the eighth line thereof the words 'at 4 least four days before such meeting' so that said section as 5 amended will read as follows:

'Section 9. The sheriff on receiving such venires, shall 7 immediately send them to the constables of the towns where 8 directed, and to the constables, marshals or deputy marshals 9 of cities, and each constable, marshal or deputy marshal on 10 receipt thereof, shall notify the voters of the town or city,

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11 and especially the municipal officers and town or city clerk,
12 by posting notices in two public and conspicuous places
13 therein, and by delivering to at least two of the municipal
14 officers and the town or city clerk written notices of said
15 meeting at least four days before such meeting to assemble
16 and be present at the draft of jurors called for, which shall
17 be six days at least before the time when they are ordered to
18 attend court.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
