RESOLVE in favor of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-three thousand one hundred and fifty dollars be and is hereby appropriated for and
2 in behalf of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital, at Bangor,
3 for the year nineteen hundred and five, and twenty-three
4 thousand one hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen
5 hundred and six, for the purpose of meeting current
6 expenses, making repairs and improvements, and purchasing
7 additional land.

Said sums to be expended under the direction of the trustees of insane hospitals.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It is necessary that an appropriation be made at each session of the legislature to meet the deficiency created by the excess of expenditures over receipts at this hospital. In addition to the deficiency, an appropriation is asked for the purpose of purchasing two tracts of land with buildings thereon adjacent to the land now owned by the hospital, and which the hospital is at present occupying under lease. The following is a detailed statement of the various items for which this appropriation is to be expended:

Additional land	4,300 00
Coal	15,000 00
Deficiency	20,000 00
Amusements	600 00
Double windows	400 00
Hot water heater.....	1,000 00
