## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum 2 of seventy-eight thousand five hundred (\$78,500) dollars, 3 for the use of the Maine Insane Hospital, for the year 1905, 4 for the following purposes:

For completion of re-construction of second female wing; 6 for re-building piggery; for fire proof stairways and copper 7 aprons for the brick buildings; for new sewer; for the 8 Maine Insane Hospital at Augusta.

For proposed renovation of building known as the Arsenal 10 building, Augusta, said building to be used for temporary

11 male wards; for pump and tank and connections with steam 12 mains including duck and protection for same; for furnish-13 ing for wards and day room, kitchen equipment and fittings 14 for the care of one hundred and twenty-five patients; pro-15 posed new road across insane and arsenal property; for 16 repairs on barracks and other buildings for protection and 17 use in connection with said building. Said sums to be 18 expended under the direction of the trustees of insane 19 hospitals.
