IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to reimburse the tow nof Chelsea.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Chelsea in the county of Kennebec

- 2 and State of Maine shall be reimbursed by the State for
- 3 relief necessarily furnished by it for support of soldiers,
- 4 who, having been inmates of the National Home at Togus,
- 5 have left said home for violation of its rules or for other
- 6 causes and have taken up their abode and acquired a settle-
- 7 ment in the town of Chelsea; and also for relief necessarily
- 8 furnished for the support of the families of such soldiers
- 9 to such an amount as the governor and council adjudge to
- 10 have been necessarily expended therefor.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
