### STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT additional to chapter twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes, relating to alien paupers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Revised Statutes shall not be construed to

- 2 make any town liable for relief furnished to an alien or his
- 3 family since said statutes went into effect, but relief fur-
- 4 nished any such person shall be within the provisions of
- 5 section thirty-three of chapter twenty-seven.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
