RESOLVE in favor of the clerk and stenographer to the Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.

Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid to Maurice
2 J. Kane the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for ser-
3 vices as clerk and messenger to the Committee on Appro-
4 priations and Financial Affairs, and that there be appro-
5 priated and paid to Annie Bibber the sum of seventy-five
6 dollars (\$75.00) for services as stenographer and typewriter
7 to the same committee.
