STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the purchase of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for the years nineteen hundred and seven and nineteen hundred and eight.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be authorized to contract for six hundred and fifty copies of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for nineteen hundred and seven; also nine hundred and fifty copies of same for nineteen hundred and eight, to be delivered on or before the first day of June of each year at a cost not to exceed two dollars per copy. One hundred and fifty of said copies for each year to be delivered to the state librarian for the use of the state library, the remainder to be distributed in the usual manner.
