STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to legalize and make valid certain doings of the town of Danforth in the county of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The action of the inhabitants of the town of Danforth in 2 Washington county in special town meeting held on the 5th 3 day of July, 1906, whereby the said inhabitants voted to 4 authorize its board of selectmen to subscribe for stock in the 5 Danforth Water Company to the amount of five thousand 6 dollars (\$5,000), under which said selectmen gave a promis-7 sory note for five thousand dollars (\$5,000) in payment for 8 said stock subscription, is hereby ratified and made valid, 9 and said town of Danforth is hereby authorized to issue its 10 bonds for the payment of said sum of \$5,000 and interest in 11 such numbers and denominations and payable in such time 12 as it sees fit.
