

## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Girl's Orphanage in the city of Lewiston under the auspices of the Sisters of Charity.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand five hundred dol-2 lars be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the society 3 of the Sisters of Charity of the city of Lewiston for the use 4 of said orphanage for the year nineteen hundred and seven 5 and two thousand five hundred dollars for the use of the 6 orphanage for the year nineteen hundred and eight.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This institution was established in eighteen hundred and seventy-eight on Walnut street in the city of Lewiston, and remained in those quarters until eighteen hundred and eighty-eight caring for fifteen orphan girls per year.

In eighteen hundred and eighty-eight they removed to their present quarters at the junction of Orange, Pine and Sabattus streets. Since this date the number of girls cared for has increased yearly until they now number more than one hundred orphan girls.

This institution is supported by money received for the board of children and the state appropriation of twenty-five hundred dollars a year. An orphan girl is received in this institution at a cost of six dollars a month for board, clothing and instruction, There is no distinction in regard to race or creed. A reference to the annual report will show that there were one hundred and five orphans cared for during the past year, and all but six were from the state of Maine.
