IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of Chapter 213, Special
Laws of 1891, entitled "An Act to incorporate the York
Light and Heat Company."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The York Light and Heat Company is hereby
2 authorized and empowered to issue bonds for the payment
3 of or refunding of its indebtedness, and for the further
4 construction and improvement of its works and plant, for
5 such an amount and upon such rate and time as it may
6 deem expedient and necessary, not to exceed the sum of
7 two hundred and fifty thousand dollars in addition to the
8 amount of its present bonded indebtedness, and may secure
9 the same by a mortgage or deed of trust upon the franchise

10 or franchises, property or estate owned by or to be here-
11 after acquired by said corporation, but said mortgage shall
12 not diminish the security of the bonds heretofore issued
13 by said corporation remaining unpaid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
