IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the South Portland Trust
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the South
2 Portland Trust Company, which were granted by chapter
3 four hundred eighty-seven of the Private and Special Laws
4 of nineteen hundred and one, and extended by chapter eighty
5 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and
6 three, for a period of two years, and extended by chapter
7 forty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
8 hundred and five, be further extended for the future period

9 of two years from the approval of this act; and the persons
10 named in said act, their associates and successors, shall have
11 all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them
12 by said act to be exercised in the same manner and for the
13 same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
