AN ACT to extend the charter of the Deering Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Deering Trust Company, which were granted by chapter ninety-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five, are hereby extended for the future period of two years from the approval of this act; and the persons named in said act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
