IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prevent the pollution of the waters of North or  
Varnum's Pond.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The local board of health of the town of Farm-  
2 ington, together with the local board of health of the town  
3 of Wilton, are created and constituted a board of health,  
4 who shall have jurisdiction over the territory covered by  
5 the waters of North or Varnum's pond, and the water shed  
6 that drains into said pond, situate partly in the town of  
7 Wilton, and partly in the town of Temple, in the county  
8 of Franklin. Said board of health shall possess all the  
9 powers, and shall have all the rights, and be under all the  
10 duties, which are by law conferred upon local boards of  
11 health.

Sect. 2. No barn, stable, sty, cess pool, privy, outhouse,  
2 or outlet of any sewer or sink-spout, shall hereafter be  
3 erected within the distance of two hundred feet of the  
4 waters of North or Varnum's pond, so called, or any tribu-  
5 tary thereof, situate in the towns of Temple and Wilton,  
6 in the county of Franklin; and being the source of the  
7 water supply for the villages of Wilton and Farmington;  
8 and any such erection within two hundred feet of said  
9 pond, or any tributary thereof, shall not be maintained, but  
10 shall be removed at the expense of the owner thereof.

Sect. 3. No sewage, drainage, refuse or polluting matter  
2 shall be discharged into said pond, or any tributary thereof,  
3 or put upon the ice thereon.

Sect. 4. The Supreme Judicial Court shall have juris-  
2 diction in equity to enjoin, prevent or restrain any violation  
3 of the provisions of this act.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
