IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 193 of the Private and Special Laws of 1887 as amended by Chapter 464 of the Private and Special Laws of 1897, relating to the Fryeburg Horse Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Fryeburg Horse Railroad Company is

- 2 hereby empowered to build and extend its road from any
- 3 points or places in the town of Fryeburg, to any points or
- 4 places in the towns of Stow and Lovell, with the same
- 5 powers and under the same conditions as apply to the build-
- 6 ing and extension of street railroads under the general laws 7 of the State.
- Sect. 2. On and after July twenty-third, 1907, said Frye-2 burg Horse Railroad Company shall have all the rights

- 3 and powers as to its present location in the town of Frye-
- 4 burg that belong to street railroads under the general laws
- 5 of the State, and without limitation as to time.
- Sect. 3. The said company is authorized to change its 2 name to Fryeburg, Stow and Lovell Street Railway Com-3 pany.
 - Sect. 4. Chapter 193 of the Private and Special Laws of
- 2 1887, as amended by Chapter 464 of the Private and Special
- 3 Laws of 1897, is hereby amended to conform to the fore-
- 4 going provisions.
 - Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
