STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend sections five and nine of chapter ninety-two of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, providing for the better enforcement of the laws against the manufacture and sale of intoxicating liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section five of chapter ninety-two of the Public
2 Laws of 1905 is hereby amended by striking out after the
3 word "shall" in the fifth line thereof the rest of said section
4 and substituting the following in place thereof:

'At each criminal term of court in the counties where they
6 have performed such duties, present their accounts to the
7 justice presiding to be allowed in the bill of costs for the
8 term and paid by the county.' So that said section as
9 amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 5. It shall be the duty of the said deputy enforcement commissioners to exercise all the powers herein conferred, when, where and as directed by said commission, and for their services, they shall be paid three dollars per day and the actual expenses occasioned by the performance of such duty, and shall, at each criminal term of court in the counties where they have performed such duties, present their accounts to the justice presiding to be allowed in the bill of costs for the term and paid by the county.’

Sect. 2. Section nine of said chapter is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and substituting the following:

‘Section 9. All fines collected by prosecutions undertaken by said commission or its deputies, and all fines collected during the time when a special attorney is appointed to perform the duties of the attorney for the state for a county, shall belong to the county in which the prosecution is had.’

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
