STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Augusta Water District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter four of the Private and 2 Special Laws for the year one thousand nine hundred and 3 five is hereby amended by adding thereto the words 'and for 4 rights of way, or roadways, to its sources of supply, dams, 5 power stations, reservoirs, mains, aqueducts, structures and 6 lands' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said district, for the purposes of its incorporation 8 is hereby authorized to take and hold, by purchase or other-9 wise, any land or interest therein or water rights necessary 10 for dams, for flowage, for power for pumping its water 11 supply through its mains, for reservoirs, for preserving the

12 purity of the water and water shed, for laying and maintain13 ing aqueducts and other structures for taking, distributing,
14 discharging and disposing of water and for rights of way, or
15 roadways, to its sources of supply, dams, power stations,
16 reservoirs, mains, aqueducts, structures and lands.'

Sect. 2. The trustees of said Augusta Water District shall, 2 on or before September first of each year, make and file with 3 the municipal officers of the city of Augusta, a report of their 4 doings as trustees of said water district, and a statement of 5 the receipts and disbursements of said water district during 6 the year ending June first next preceding, and that shall be 7 deemed the fiscal year of said water district.

Sect. 3. The said water district is hereby authorized to 2 supply water under the rights and duties of its charter, in 3 that portion of Winthrop known as East Winthrop and along 4 its existing pipe line.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
