STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to change the name of the Maine Congregational Charitable Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The Maine Congregational Charitable Society,
- 2 a corporation chartered by the state of Maine and acting
- 3 through executive officers, most of whom reside in Bangor,
- 4 is authorized, without loss of any of its present rights, to
- 5 assume the name of Maine Congregational Ministerial Relief
- 6 Society, and henceforth to transact its affairs under the
- 7 latter name.
- Sect. 2. In particular, this corporation henceforth known
- 2 as the Maine Congregational Ministerial Relief Society, shall
- 3 have the right to claim, receive and hold any and all legacies

- 4 or other gifts which have been made or given to the Maine
- 5 Congregational Charitable Society, or which may at any time
- 6 hereafter be given to the Maine Congregational Charitable
- 7 Society, so that the change of name shall in no respect cause
- 8 the corporation to forfeit any right which it would have had
- 9 if it should have retained its former name.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
