## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT for the better protection of Shell Fish within the town of Yarmouth in the county of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. No shell fish shall be taken from any flats within 2 the limits of the town of Yarmouth, in Cumberland county, 3 except by written permit of the municipal officers of the said 4 town of Yarmouth and North Yarmouth, and payment to 5 the said towns for the privilege at such price as said towns 6 may establish at any town meeting, any existing laws to the 7 contrary notwithstanding; provided, that without such 8 permit, any inhabitant within said towns, or any person 9 temporarily resident therein, or the riparian owner of such

10 flats, may take therefrom for the immediate use of himself 11 or his family, not exceeding one bushel at one tide.

Sect. 2. Any person taking shell fish contrary to the pro-2 visions of this act, shall be punished for each offense by a 3 fine not exceeding ten dollars, or by imprisonment not 4 exceeding thirty days or by both.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
