STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to the Employment of Custodians of
Elevators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No person firm or corporation shall employ or
2 permit any person under fifteen years of age to have the care,
3 custody, management or operation of any elevator or shall
4 employ a person under eighteen years of age to have the
5 care, custody, management or operation of any elevator run-
6 ning at a speed of over two hundred feet a minute.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall
2 be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars
3 and not less than twenty-five dollars for each offense.
