
STATE OF MAINE.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 403 of the Private and Special Laws of Maine, 1903, entitled "An Enabling Act for the annexation of the City of South Portland to Portland."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 403 of the Private and Special Laws 2 of 1903, entitled "An Enabling Act for the annexation of 3 the City of South Portland to Portland," is hereby repealed. Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
