## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize a bridge in the town of Edgecomb.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Edgecomb in the county of Lin2 coln and State of Maine is hereby authorized to erect and
3 maintain a free bridge in substantially the place and manner
4 the same is now constructed across a cove on the easterly
5 side of the Sheepscot river in said Edgecomb, between
6 upland belonging to John P. Chase (formerly belonging to
7 Norris & Gay) and upland belonging to Caroline P. Trask,
8 as a part of a town road laid out by the selectmen of the
9 said town of Edgecomb, May 4, 1903, and accepted by said
10 town May 13, 1903.

Sect. 2. Said bridge originally constructed in the year 2 1904 is hereby made and constituted a legal, proper, author-3 ized and valid bridge, to all intents and purposes as though 4 this act had been passed prior to the construction thereof. Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
