STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter two hundred and forty-two of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninetyfive, entitled "An Act to incorporate the city of South Portland," as amended by Chapter one hundred thirty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Item two of section twenty-three of chapter 2 two hundred and forty-two of Private and Special Laws of 3 eighteen hundred and ninety-five, as amended by chapter 4 one hundred thirty-eight of the Private and Special Laws 5 of nineteen hundred and five, is hereby further amended 6 so that the same shall read as follows:

HOUSE-No. 68.

'Item 2. Said court shall have exclusive original juris-8 diction of all offenses against the ordinances and by-laws 9 of said city, and of the local board of health therein, and 10 concurrent jurisdiction of all such criminal offenses and II misdemeanors committed therein as are cognizable by trial 12 justices, and concurrent jurisdiction of all civil actions in 13 the county of Cumberland wherein the debt or damages 14 demanded do not exceed twenty dollars, except when the 15 judge of said court is interested in any such action as party 16 or attorney; and original jurisdiction concurrent with the 17 superior court of the county of Cumberland in all civil 18 actions wherein the debt or damages do not exceed fifty 10 dollars, exclusive of costs, in which any party to the action 20 or person summoned as trustee shall reside, or, if not an 21 inhabitant of the State, shall be commorant or have a place 22 of business, in said city.'
