IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

---

AN ACT to extend the provisions of Chapter two hundred and forty-one of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, entitled "An Act to supply the town of Lisbon with pure water."

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges which were  
2 granted to the town of Lisbon by chapter two hundred and  
3 forty-one of the Private and Special Laws of the year nine-  
4 teen hundred and three, are hereby extended for and during  
5 the period of two years from the twenty-fourth day of  
6 March, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and seven,  
7 and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted

8 by said act may and shall be exercised in the same manner  
9 and for the same purpose as provided in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect March twenty-fourth,  
2 nineteen hundred and seven.
