STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the provisions of Chapter two hundred and forty-one of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, entitled "An Act to supply the town of Lisbon with pure water."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges which were

- 2 granted to the town of Lisbon by chapter two hundred and
- 3 forty-one of the Private and Special Laws of the year nine-
- 4 teen hundred and three, are hereby extended for and during
- 5 the period of two years from the twenty-fourth day of
- 6 March, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and seven,
- 7 and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted

- 8 by said act may and shall be exercised in the same manner 9 and for the same purpose as provided in said act.
- Sect. 2. This act shall take effect March twenty-fourth, 2 nineteen hundred and seven.
