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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT additional to Chapter 127 of the Revised Statutes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever enters into an agreement to labor for  
2 another in any lumbering operation or in driving logs and  
3 in consideration thereof receives any advance of goods,  
4 money, or transportation, and unreasonably and with intent  
5 to defraud fails to enter into said employment as agreed,  
6 and labor for a sufficient length of time to reimburse his  
7 employer for said advances and expenses of transportation,  
8 shall be punished by fine of not exceeding ten dollars or  
9 by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.

Sect. 2. Judges of municipal courts and trial justices shall  
2 have jurisdiction of the offence described in this act.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
