IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

---

AN ACT to authorize the City of Lewiston to issue its bonds to the amount of one hundred seventy-four thousand dollars (\$174,000.00) to pay its bonds now outstanding and maturing in the year one thousand nine hundred and seven.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. To meet its bonds now outstanding and maturing in the year one thousand nine hundred and seven, the City of Lewiston is authorized to issue bonds to an amount not exceeding one hundred seventy-four thousand dollars, payable at a period or periods, not exceeding thirty years after the date thereof, and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding four per cent per annum, payable semi-annually. Said bonds shall be issued under the seal of the city and

9 shall be signed by the mayor and treasurer of the city, and  
10 the coupons attached to said bonds shall have the printed  
11 or lithographed signatures of the city treasurer.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
