## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Phillips Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the Phillips Trust 2 Company, which were granted by chapter three hundred 3 and twenty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nine-4 teen hundred and three, and extended by chapter eighty-5 five of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred 6 and five, are hereby extended for two years from the 7 approval of this act; and the persons named in said act, 8 their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, 9 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act, 10 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-11 poses as therein specified.
