STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to better protect the lobster industry within two miles
from the shore of Monhegan Island between the first day of
June and the twenty-fifth day of November of each year.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill, destroy
2 or set any lobster trap or other device for the purpose of
3 taking, catching, killing or destroying, any lobster or lob-
4 sters within two miles of the shore of Monhegan Island
5 between the first day of June and the twenty-fifth of Novem-
6 ber of each and every year.

Sect. 2. Any person violating the provisions of the foregoing section shall be punished by a fine of one dollar for each and every lobster taken, caught, killed or destroyed, and of five dollars for each lobster trap or other device set, contrary to the provisions of the foregoing section. Trial justices and judges of police and municipal courts shall have jurisdiction of all offenses under this act.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect on the first day of June, 2 nineteen hundred and seven.
