## STATE OF MAINE.

---

RESOLVE, to appropriate \$250 to screen Sabattus pond, in  
the County of Androscoggin.

---

*Resolved:* That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars  
2 be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of screening  
3 Sabattus pond or lake, so-called, in the county of Andro-  
4 scoggin, to be expended under the direction of the Commis-  
5 sioners of **Inland Fisheries and Game**, when the balance nec-  
6 essary to erect said screen, as found by the Commissioners,  
7 shall have been raised by the citizens of the County of  
8 Androscoggin and paid into the treasurer of state for the  
9 purpose.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be avail-  
11 able until the town of Webster shall have, in legal town  
12 meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town

13 meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume  
14 all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from  
15 sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become  
16 clogged and prevent the free running of the water through  
17 the same.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The legislature of 1905 made an appropriation of \$250 under the same conditions as this Resolve, but owing to the conditions existing during the summer of 1905 and 1906, as regards the height of the water in the pond the screen was not erected, therefore the appropriation lapsed and is no longer available. This resolve is introduced in order that the original appropriation made by the state may again be available, as the amount to be raised by private subscription is already pledged.
