IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the City of Bath to raise money by the
issue of Bonds for the construction of sewers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The city of Bath is hereby authorized to issue
2 bonds to an amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars
3 (\$50,000.00) for the purpose of constructing main sewers
4 in said city in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 21
5 of the Revised Statutes (1903) and acts amendatory thereof
6 and additional thereto and Chapter 22 of the Private and
7 Special Laws of 1903. Said bonds to be issued subject to
8 the following restrictions.

(A) Said bonds shall be four (4) per cent. coupon bonds,
10 dated January 1st, 1907 and due January 1st, 1927; they

11 shall be in denominations of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)
12 each and shall be numbered from one to one hundred
13 inclusive.

(B) Said city shall not in any year sell or offer for sale
15 more of said bonds than the amount appropriated that year
16 by the city council for the reduction of the city debt.

Sect. 2. Said bonds shall be issued under the seal of the
2 city and shall be signed by the mayor and treasurer of the
3 city and the coupons attached to said bonds shall have printed
4 or lithographed thereon the signature of the city treasurer.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
